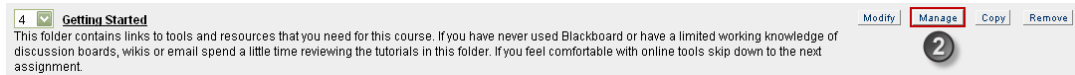


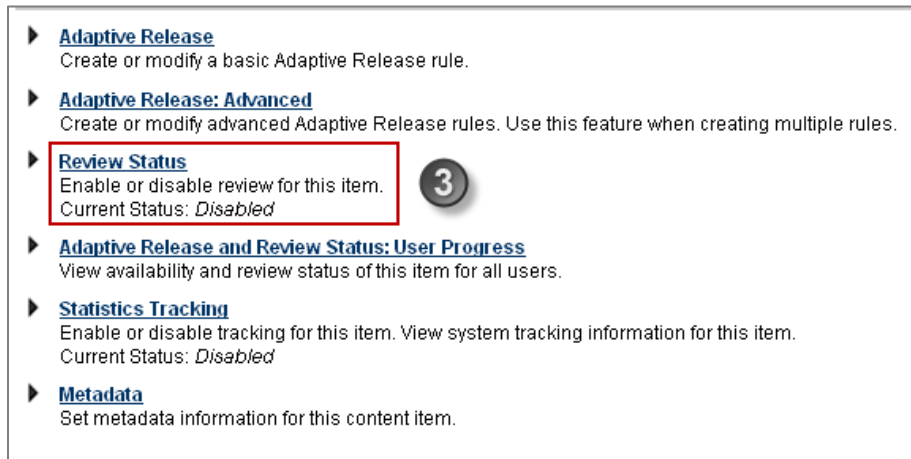
Adaptive Release

To set review status restrictions on activities or resources:

1. Open the **Control Panel** in the course for which you wish to create a review rule.
2. Click on the **[Manage]** button of the module or item that will be tracked.



3. Next click on the **Review Status** link. The **Review Status** dialog box will be displayed.



4. Click on the **Enable** radio button.
5. Then click on the **[Submit]** button.

To release materials based on review status restrictions:

1. Open the **Control Panel** in the course for which you wish to create an Adaptive Release rule.
2. Navigate to the **Content Area** that contains the assignment that will be restricted.

3. Click on the **[Manage]** button to the right of the piece of content, or exam that will remain hidden until the requirement has been met. The manage page will be displayed.

4. Next click on the **Adaptive Release** link.

Create or modify advanced Adaptive Release rules. Use this feature when creating multiple rules.
- ▶ **Review Status**
Enable or disable review for this item.

5. Scroll down to the **Review Status** area.
6. Click the **[Browse]** button to the right of the **Select an item** text field. The **Course Map** will be displayed.

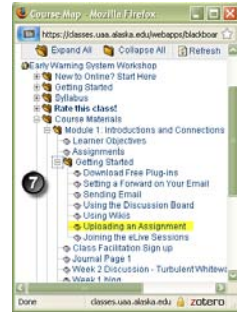
4 Review Status

This content item is visible to all users until a Review Status criteria is met. **6** Selecting an item will enable Review for that item.

Select an item **Browse...**

7. Select the item that must be reviewed prior to piece of content or exam is released. For this example:

- Click on the “+” icon to the left of the “**Getting Started**” folder to see the folder contents.
- Click on the “**Uploading Assignments**” entry.



8. The **Course Map** will disappear and the “**Uploading Assignments**” path will appear in the **Select an item** text field.

Click **Submit** to finish. Click **Cancel** to quit.

9. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the **[Submit]** button to save your changes.
